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1 INTRODUCTION AND SUMMARY

This is a Final Rate Order of the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on an application filed by Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro Inc. (Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro) to change its electricity distribution rates as of January 1, 2020.

The OEB has reviewed Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro's draft rate order (DRO) and proposed Tariff of Rates and Charges, and is satisfied that they accurately reflect the Decision and Order (Decision) issued on October 17, 2019.¹

As a result of this Final Rate Order, it is estimated that for a typical residential customer with monthly consumption of 750 kWh, the total bill will increase by \$2.23 per month, an increase of 1.71%, before taxes.

2 THE PROCESS

On October 17, 2019, the OEB issued the Decision in which it accepted the settlement proposal filed by Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro and intervenors to this proceeding. In the Decision, the OEB directed Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro to file a DRO with updated 2020 cost of capital parameters as contemplated in the settlement proposal. The Decision also allowed for submissions from Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro, OEB staff, and intervenors on the DRO.

On November 7, 2019, Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro filed its DRO with a proposed Tariff of Rates and Charges. On November 14, 2019, OEB staff filed its submission on the DRO and submitted that Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro had accurately reflected the Decision.

No other submissions were received for the DRO.

3 RATE ORDER

The OEB has reviewed the information provided in support of Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro's DRO and proposed Tariff of Rates and Charges. The OEB finds that the DRO accurately reflects the Decision.

The Specific Service Charges have most recently been amended by the OEB through: the Report of the OEB – “Wireline Pole Attachment Charges”² and the Decision and Order on Energy Retail Service Charges.³ Certain Service Charges are subject to annual inflationary adjustments to be determined by the OEB through a generic order.

Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro has updated the Retail Service Charges and Pole Attachment Charge in the Tariff of Rates and Charges by increasing the 2019 charge by the OEB's 2020 inflation rate. This calculation is consistent with the Report of the OEB and the Decision and Order mentioned above.

The OEB has made some minor changes to the wording of the 2020 Tariff of Rates and Charges to ensure consistency with the tariff sheets of other Ontario electricity distributors. The final approved Tariff of Rates and Charges is attached as Schedule A to this Final Rate Order.

The new rates approved in this Final Rate Order are to be effective and implemented on January 1, 2020.

4 ORDER

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. The Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Schedule A of this Final Rate Order is final effective January 1, 2020 and is to be implemented January 1, 2020. The Tariff of Rates and Charges will apply to electricity consumed or estimated to have been consumed on and after January 1, 2020. Kitchener Wilmot Hydro Inc. shall notify its customers of the rate changes no later than the delivery of the first bill reflecting the new rates.

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE CLASSIFICATION

This classification applies to an account taking electricity at 750 volts or less where the electricity is used exclusively in a separate metered living accommodation. Customers shall be residing in single-dwelling units that consist of a detached house or one unit of a semi-detached, duplex, triplex or quadruplex house, with a residential zoning. Separately metered dwellings within a town house complex or apartment building also qualify as residential customers. All customers are single-phase. Class B consumers are defined in accordance with O. Reg. 429/04. Further servicing details are available in the distributor's Conditions of Service.

APPLICATION

The application of these rates and charges shall be in accordance with the Licence of the Distributor and any Code or Order of the Ontario Energy Board, and amendments thereto as approved by the Ontario Energy Board, which may be applicable to the administration of this schedule.

No rates and charges for the distribution of electricity and charges to meet the costs of any work or service done or furnished for the purpose of the distribution of electricity shall be made except as permitted by this schedule, unless required by the Distributor's Licence or a Code or Order of the Ontario Energy Board, and amendments thereto as approved by the Ontario Energy Board, or as specified herein.

Unless specifically noted, this schedule does not contain any charges for the electricity commodity, be it under the Regulated Price Plan, a contract with a retailer or the wholesale market price, as applicable. In addition, the charges in the MONTHLY RATES AND CHARGES - Regulatory Component of this schedule do not apply to a customer that is an embedded wholesale market participant.

It should be noted that this schedule does not list any charges, assessments, or credits that are required by law to be invoiced by a distributor and that are not subject to Ontario Energy Board approval, such as the Debt Retirement Charge, the Global Adjustment and the HST.

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GENERAL SERVICE 50 TO 4,999 KW SERVICE CLASSIFICATION

This classification applies to a non residential account whose average monthly maximum demand used for billing purposes is equal to or greater than, or is forecast to be equal to or greater than, 50 kW but less than 5,000 kW. Note that for the application of the Retail Transmission Rate - Network Service Rate and the Retail Transmission Rate - Line and Transformation Connection Service Rate the following sub-classifications apply: General Service 50 to 999 kW non-interval metered, General Service 50 to 999 kW interval metered and General Service 1,000 to 4,999 kW interval metered. Class A and Class B consumers are defined in accordance with O. Reg. 429/04. Further servicing details are available in the distributor's Conditions of Service.

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The rate rider for the disposition of WMS - Sub-account CBR Class B is not applicable to wholesale market participants (WMP), customers that transitioned between Class A and Class B during the variance account accumulation period, or to customers that were in Class A for the entire period. Customers who transitioned are to be charged or refunded their share of the variance disposed through customer specific billing adjustments. This rate rider is to be consistently applied for the entire period to the sunset date of the rate rider. In addition, this rate rider is applicable to all new Class B customers.

The rate rider for the disposition of Global Adjustment is only applicable to non-RPP Class B customers. It is not applicable to WMP, customers that transitioned between Class A and Class B during the variance account accumulation period, or to customers that were in Class A for the entire period. Customers who transitioned are to be charged or refunded their share of the variance disposed through customer billing adjustments. This rate rider is to be consistently applied for the entire period to the sunset date of the rate rider. In addition, this rate rider is applicable to all new non-RPP Class B customers.

It should be noted that this schedule does not list any charges, assessments, or credits that are required by law to be invoiced by a distributor and that are not subject to Ontario Energy Board approval, such as the Debt Retirement Charge, the Global Adjustment and the HST.

Such connections include cable TV power packs, bus shelters, telephone booths, traffic lights, railway crossings, etc. The level of the consumption will be agreed to by the distributor and the customer, based on detailed manufacturer information/ documentation with regard to electrical consumption of the unmetered load or periodic monitoring of actual consumption. Class B consumers are defined in accordance with O. Reg. 429/04. Further servicing details are available in the distributor's Conditions of Service.
